★ What is PAX Heroes?

The PAX Heroes training equips experienced PAX teachers with strategies for students in PAX classrooms who continue to face behavioral challenges. The training includes guidance on using the PAX Heroes manual to identify areas of student difficulty, refine PAX Good Behavior Game® (PAX GBG) implementation, and select targeted Tier 2 and Tier 3 supports to enhance behavioral and academic outcomes.

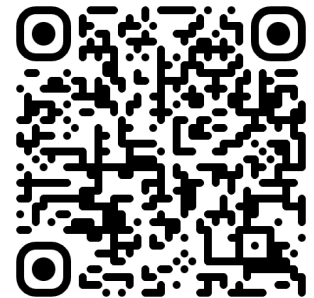

★ About PAX Heroes Training

PAX Heroes training is available in live virtual and in-person formats and includes 6 hours of content on adapting and differentiating PAX strategies for students needing extra support. Participants receive the PAX Heroes manual and guidance on how to use the PAX Up! App for implementing and monitoring their use of PAX Heroes in the classroom.

★ Who should attend PAX Heroes Training?

PAX GBG initial training is a prerequisite for PAX Heroes training, along with strong classroom implementation of PAX GBG in order to maximize benefits. PAX Heroes training is ideal for teachers, intervention specialists, counselors, and other school professionals who specialize in behavior.



- Increases the effectiveness of PAX strategies and PAX Games for students with behavioral difficulties.
- Is intended for use with PAX GBG strategies already in full use.
- Can be implemented as part of daily classroom instruction to operationalize PBIS, MTSS, and similar initiatives.
- Does not require students to be pulled from the classroom or given intensive one-on-one instruction.
- Does not require additional support staff.
- Utilizes peer support.
- Helps students succeed by creating opportunities for success in areas where it has been lacking or inconsistent.
- Is useful in general education classrooms, self-contained classrooms, or areas outside the classroom.
